Meeting called to order at 7:00p.m. by Supervisor Dean, present Dean, M Sedlacek, J Sedlacek, Smith, and Roop.

**J Sedlacek/Roop: move to approve minutes of regular meeting April 12, 2006, Special information meetings of April 12, and April 25, 2006. Carried 5/0.**

Approval of Agenda: **J Sedlacek/Smith; move to approve agenda with corrections. Carried 5/0.** Additions under new business, Ron Taylor Fire Dept. trees for Mayfield Pond Park.

Public Input: Presentations by public against and in support for locating an Ethanol plant in Summit City.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **Ron Taylor Fire Dept:** explained the role of the Fire Dept in approving plans for building an ethanol plant and what measures will be taken to protect the public.
2. **Resolution:** J Sedlacek/M Sedlacek; **approve resolution #06-05-03a (a resolution of support for Nextgen Energy Inc.). Dean yes, J Sedlacek yes, Smith yes, Roop yes, M Sedlacek yes. Carried 5/0.**
3. **Chris Durfee:** asked the board for monetary support for Heritage Day to be held on August 26, 2006 in the village of Kingsley. Also asked for manpower. Township Board is not able to legally give money to non-governmental agencies. Also informed the Board that Kingsley Baptist Church will hold a yard sale in the parking lot of the church with booths for individuals to be held at the same time as the village wide yard sale.
4. **CCS Park:** Jack Rawlings explained the progress on CCS and the need for additional money. **J Sedlacek/Smith; contribute \$5000 dollars towards the park. Roll Call Vote; M Sedlacek yes, J Sedlacek yes, Dean yes, Smith yes, Roop yes. Carried 5/0.**
5. **ZA Resumes:** each board member to review resumes and present their top 3 choices to Cheri as soon as possible so as to set up interviews.

Smith yes, Roop yes, M Sedlacek yes, J Sedlacek yes, Dean yes. Carried 5/0.**
