New Business:

1. Resolution, Light at intersection of Clark and M-113: **J Sedlacek/Smith adopt resolution #06-06-07. Roll Call vote; M Sedlacek yes, J Sedlacek yes, Dean yes, Smith yes, Roop yes. Carried 5/0.**
2. Recycle bins. American Waste has requested permission to locate recycle bins on township property. **J Sedlacek/Roop: Table until next board meeting June 14, 2006 for further study. Carried 5/0.**
3. Charter Communications: **Roop/M Sedlacek; authorize Marvin Radke Jr to order Internet hook-up through Charter for Township offices. Carried 5/0.**
4. Mayfield Pond Park: the park needs more trash receptacles for more frequent pick-up. Dean will check and see which is the more feasible.
5. Spring Pick-up: Dean wants to know who will be able to work. Roop, M Sedlacek, J Sedlacek, plan to work on it that day. M Sedlacek also stated that some of the volunteer firefighters would be there.
6. Stone: Stone from the old Kingsley maintenance building with the inscription Paradise Township established 1906 has been brought to our new Building. **J Sedlacek/ M Sedlacek: move to pay Rodney Bogart \$100 for expenses incurred in removal and transportation. Carried 5/0.**
7. Senior Citizens: Senior citizens of Kingsley need a government entity to sign a form requesting a grant from ^{Seniors on} Agency on Aging. **M Sedlacek/Roop: motion to sponsor the Senior Citizens of Kingsley in their request for funding. Carried 5/0.**
8. Newsletter: reminder from Dean that inserts for the newsletter that will go out with the tax bills must be submitted by June 14.
9. Forest: M Sedlacek/ J Sedlacek; move to hire for forest inspection on township property. Carried 5/0.

New Business;

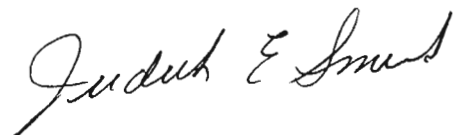
1. Cemetery: Evergreen Cemetery has requested funds for the purchase of a new storage building for lawn tractors and other equipment.
