

## Paradise Township Parks and Recreation meeting minutes for September 22nd, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:04pm

Public input: None

1. Marvin Radtke presented to the committee how the new agreement with the Village of Kingsley will work to develop a joint Parks and Recreation Master Plan. This agreement will only be for the Master Plan. Marvin suggested that we add to the Village plan (what is currently in our plan) because of how far along the Village is. Committee will look over the Village Parks and Recreation plan and make any additions felt needed and return to Marvin by October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
2. Mayfield Pond Park was vandalized again (Four times now this summer) and the Grand Traverse County Sheriff's Department will be contacted to install video cameras. A sign count is still needed for the park which will be done at the next committee meeting.
3. Steve Largent addressed the committee about the buffer strip around Mayfield Pond. All vegetation has been killed and the Grand Traverse Conservation District will start planting the new trees and shrubs within the next two weeks. Larget also expressed concern over the vandalism hoping that whoever is doing this will not damage the new trees when planted.
4. Committee has been given a copy of the new rental agreement for the pavilion at Mayfield Pond Park. Committee will review and return to the Township hall by October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2009 for any corrections or additions.
